## Global Technical Assistance

- Peer TA provided to AIDS program staff and national, state, and regional AIDS committees and AIDS programs in other countries
- Team-based approach
- May be one-time TA, but most often is long-term; while team-members may change, the TA relationship in country is sustained over time
- Focused on state/regional government management of comprehensive HIV/AIDS programs
