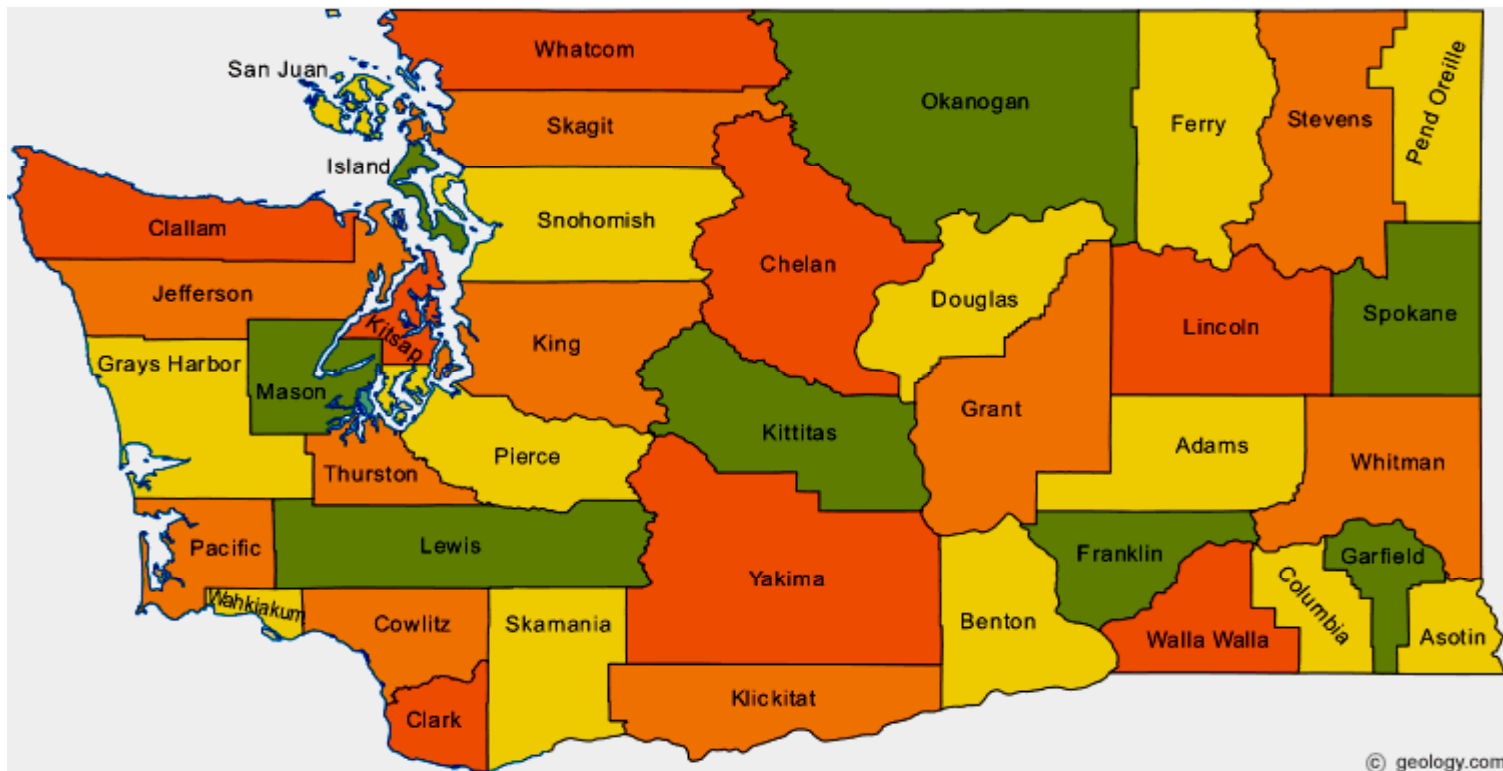


Factors that Contribute to Internet Use and STI's in Washington State.

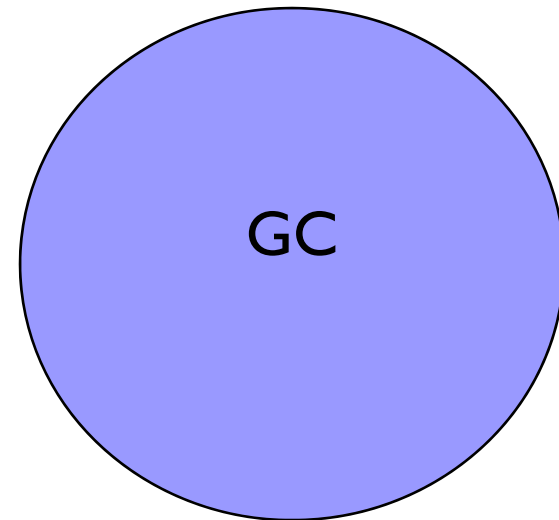
Results of multivariate analysis for predictors of ever using the Internet to meet sex partners for interviewed male gonorrhea and syphilis cases, Washington 2007-2008 (n=1764, R²=0.25).

Parameter	Adjusted Odds Ratio	95% Confidence Interval	P value
MSM	10.211	7.401, 14.089	<0.0001
HIV positive	1.211	0.888, 1.633	0.2083
Age			0.0653
White race	1.516	1.171, 2.040	0.0021
Hispanic ethnicity	0.957	0.676, 1.354	0.8035
More than one partner	2.733	2.154, 3.488	<0.0001
GC disease	2.091	1.557, 2.791	<0.0001
Any drug use, past year*	1.800	1.401, 2.313	<0.0001

***Any drug use includes: past year crack, meth, heroin, cocaine, any IDU, nitates, and any needle share**

Core GC Group

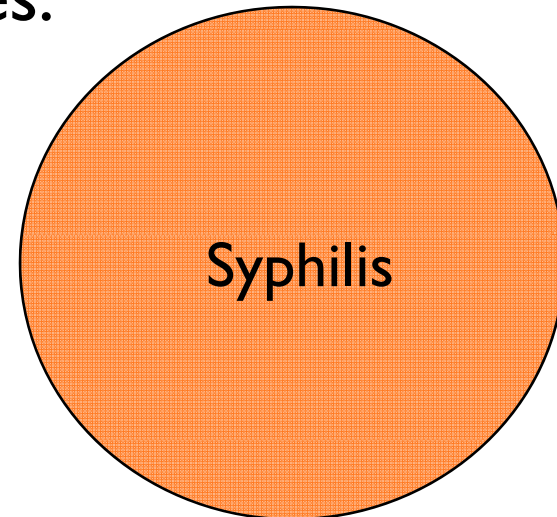
- Number of GC cases for 2007/08 = 2489.
- Self-reported co-infection rate of 15%.
- 2.1 times more likely to use the internet to meet SP's.
- If more than 1 SP then 2.7 times more likely to have used the internet.





Core Syphilis Group

- Number of Syphilis cases for 2007/08 = 348.
- Self-reported co-infection rate of 40%.
- Previous analysis indicates that this population tends to meet their SP's at bathhouses.





Multivariate Analysis of GC/Syphilis Cases for 2007/2008 in Washington State.

- Convenience Sample of 1764 Males.
- MSM=999 and Hetero=765 or Other.
- Analysis of two separate core groups MSM with GC and/or Syph.
- Number of GC cases for 2007/08 2489.
- Number of P/S Syph cases for 2007/08 348.



Factors that tend to predict report of ever using the Internet to meet sex partners among interviewed male gonorrhea and syphilis cases, Washington 2007-2008 (n=1764).

	Adjusted Odds Ratio†
MSM	10.2
More than one partner	2.7
Gonorrhea disease	2.1
Any drug use, past year*	1.9

† all *P* values <0.0001

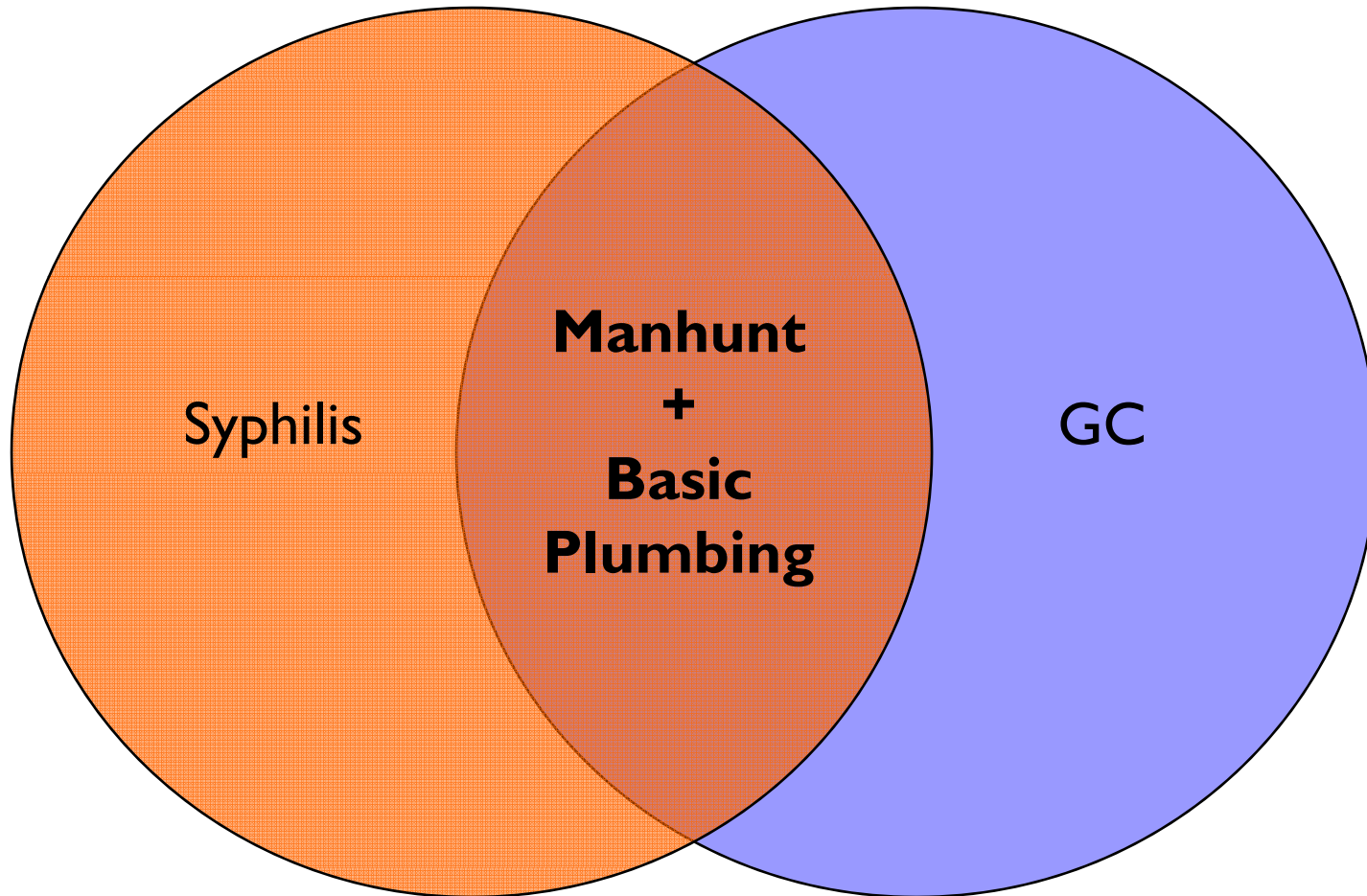
