### Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America



**75%** 

reduction in new HIV infections

by 2025

and at least

90%

reduction by 2030.



Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

**Treat** people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.






**Prevent** new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

**Respond** quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.

### Key Highlights for Health Departments

#### PS19-1906 Component B: Accelerating State and Local HIV Planning

- "Final" EHE plans are due by Dec. 31, 2020
- All plans must be posted on a public-facing website

# PS20-2010: Ending the HIV Epidemic: Integrated HIV Programs for Health Departments to Support EHE in the US

Start Date: August 1, 2020 (5-year award)

- Component A: Ending the HIV Epidemic (core)
  - Up to 10% of award may be used for viral hepatitis/STD/TB screening activities performed in conjunction with HIV testing
- Component C: Scaling Up HIV Prevention Services in STD Clinics (optional)

### NASTAD's Role in EHE: HRSA

#### 20-089: EHE Systems Coordination Provider (SCP)

- **Focus:** SCP is responsible for assisting HRSA-20-078 recipients with coordinating and integrating their plans, funding sources and programs with existing HIV care delivery systems.
- Recipient: NASTAD
- Proposed Activities:
  - Assess EHE plans and identify common systems coordination priorities
  - Engaging key stakeholders across health systems by providing high-intensity TA to ten high EHE jurisdictions during year one
  - Disseminations of promising practices and innovative strategies
- Duration: March 1, 2020 through February 28, 2025

### NASTAD's Role in EHE: CDC

#### PS19-1906 Component A

Strategic Partnerships and Planning to Support Ending the HIV Epidemic in the United States

- Focus: Providing support for the 57 Phase 1 EHE jurisdictions
- Recipient: NASTAD
- **Duration:** Sept. 30, 2019 Sept. 29, 2024

#### PS19-1904 Track C Supplemental (South)


**Capacity Building Assistance Supplemental Regional Project** 

- Focus: Providing support specific to community engagement within southern EHE jurisdictions
- Recipients: NASTAD (South), AIDS United (Midwest), CAPTC (West), NYC CBA (Northeast)
- **Duration:** Aug. 1, 2020 Mar. 31, 2021


