ACA PREVENTIVE SERVICES COVERAGE AND COST SHARING REQUIREMENTS

Population	Recommendation	Grade
Persons at high risk of HIV acquisition	The USPSTF recommends that clinicians offer pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) with effective antiretroviral therapy to persons who are at high risk of HIV acquisition	Α

- The ACA requires most private insurance plans and Medicaid expansion programs to cover U.S. Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) services with a Grade A or B without cost sharing
- The mandate applies to all non-grandfathered plans, including ACA Marketplace plans, fully insured group plans, and self-insured plans
- In June 2021, federal agencies clarified that the coverage and cost-sharing requirements include not only the PrEP medication, but all of the labs, clinic visits, and counseling services that go with the medication
- The federal guidance also clarified that plans could preference one medication over another as long as clinical criteria were followed (i.e., plans can preference generic TDF/FTC over Descovy as long as there is exception for clinically recommended access to Descovy)
- The USPSTF is currently finalizing an update to the USPSTF recommendation for PrEP that will include Apretude as well

CHALLENGING COST SHARING CHARGES FOR PREP


What kind of plan do I have?

- Qualified Health Plan (I bought it through the Marketplace or in the ACA regulated individual market)
- Group fully insured
- Self-insured (usually large employers)
- Non-federal government plan (e.g., municipal)

Where should I file a complaint?

- Plan
- Benefits administrator
- Employer Human Resources
- State Department of Insurance
- Department of Labor (DOL)
- Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)

BUT WHAT ABOUT BRAIDWOOD...

- In March, a federal district judge in Texas issued a nationwide injunction immediately striking down the ACA's requirements for plans to cover USPSTF Grade A and B services issued before 2010 without cost sharing
- The federal government has appealed the decision and has asked for a "stay," during appeal, which would leave the coverage and cost-sharing requirements in place during the appeal
- There is a lot at stake on appeal as the plaintiffs have filed a cross appeal attempting to get *all* of the ACA's preventive services struck down, not just the USPSTF services
- BUT... reason to believe that plans won't immediately end coverage of preventive services without cost sharing
