1. Normalize HIV Testing



2. Increase Access to PrEP



3. Standardize Early Linkage to Care

Diagnose the undiagnosed early in the course of infection

Achieve 95% viral load suppression rate for patients receiving HIV care

Build capacity for PrEP & PEP service delivery

Engage persons with HIV & link to care within 48 hours of diagnosis

Support efforts to reduce HIV transmission among high-risk groups

To reduce the rate of new HIV infections by 75% and achieve an AIDS-free county.

We envision a community where new HIV infections are rare, people living with HIV receive the care they need, and young people grow up in a world without AIDS.
