

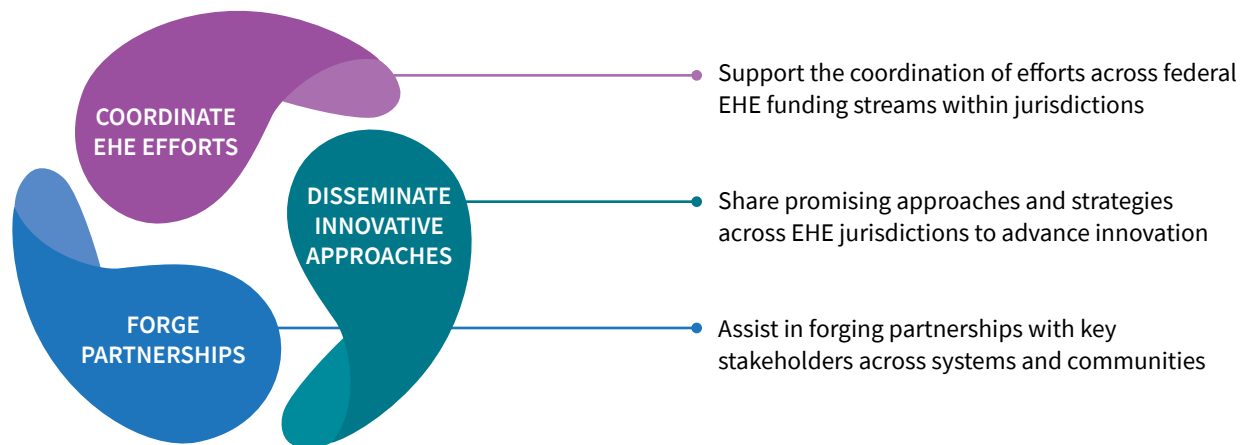
Background

The Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) funds 39 metropolitan areas and 8 states ([HRSA-20-078](#)), as part of the Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) Initiative. NASTAD serves as the EHE Systems Coordination Provider (SCP) and collaborates with CAI, the Technical Assistance Provider for this initiative, to deliver technical assistance (TA) to RWHAP funded jurisdictions.

Purpose



Approach

NASTAD will invite a small cohort of jurisdictions to participate in tailored coordination activities, including support toward:

- Convening jurisdiction-specific virtual consultations or working groups to support coordination across program areas and agencies that the health department identifies as crucial to EHE goals, including logistical support and facilitation
- Making subject matter experts available for guidance, questions, and troubleshooting
- Gathering and sharing innovative strategies from peer health departments and facilitating their adaptation through peer-to-peer TA

Project Period

March 1, 2020- February 28, 2025

Partners

NASTAD is implementing this project in partnership with JSI Research & Training Institute, Inc. (JSI), the Association of State Health Officials (ASTHO), the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO), and the Southern AIDS Coalition (SAC).



Ongoing TA

NASTAD is developing tools and resources to assist all EHE Phase I RWHAP Part A and B **recipients** to improve coordination across EHE stakeholders and health systems. These include a set of resources to scan the jurisdiction's stakeholder network, policy, and financing landscape. Throughout the project, NASTAD will gather and share innovative strategies across EHE jurisdictions and facilitate their adoption through peer TA.
