



Rhode Island Ending the HIV Epidemic



1

Through primary prevention, **reduce new HIV infections** through public education/awareness, needle exchange, condom distribution, and PrEP



2

Increase early diagnosis of HIV through targeted community-based HIV rapid testing, partner services, and state-supported medical services



3

Increase the number of HIV+ individuals in medical care and taking medication. **Reduce barriers to HIV care** through Return to Care Program, case management, and workforce development



4

Reduce HIV viral loads and disrupt disease transmission (Undetectable = Untransmittable) **Respond rapidly** to detect and respond to growing HIV clusters



75% reduction in new HIV infections in **5 years** and at least **90%** reduction in **10 years**
